

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
PEYTON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Peyton Fire Protection District (“PFPD”) is organized pursuant to C.R.S. §32-1-101 et. seq (the “Special District Act”); and,

WHEREAS, C.R.S. §32-1-1001(j)(I) authorizes the Board to fix and from time to time to increase or decrease fees, rates, tolls, penalties, or charges for services, programs, or facilities furnished by the special district; and,

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2026 the Board of Directors of the PFPD considered and approved the 2026 Fee Rate Schedule, attached hereto as Exhibit A at a public meeting of the PFPD (“2026 Fee Schedule”) and determined that the 2026 Fee Schedule was a fair allocation of costs to help defray the actual costs associated with providing services, programs and facilities of the PFPD and,

WHEREAS, the 2026 Fee Schedule does not unilaterally impose a fee, rate, toll, or charge for responding to, combating, or extinguishing a fire occurring on taxable real or personal property, buildings, or facilities located within the fire protection district’s jurisdictional boundaries.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PEYTON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT THAT:

- (1) The 2026 Fee Schedule is hereby adopted.
- (2) The PFPD administration shall employ a uniform system for the assessment and collection of monies generated through the 2026 Fee Schedule.
- (3) Once assessed and until paid, all fees, rates, tolls, penalties, or charges constitute a perpetual lien on and against the property served, and, except as provided by statute, any such lien may be foreclosed in the same manner as provided by the laws of this state for the foreclosure of mechanics’ liens.
- (4) The Board of Directors deems it appropriate that this Resolution be published on the District website and that this Resolution be available for inspection and acquisition in the office of the PFPD.

This Resolution was adopted on January 13, 2026, by a unanimous vote of the Board of Directors.
